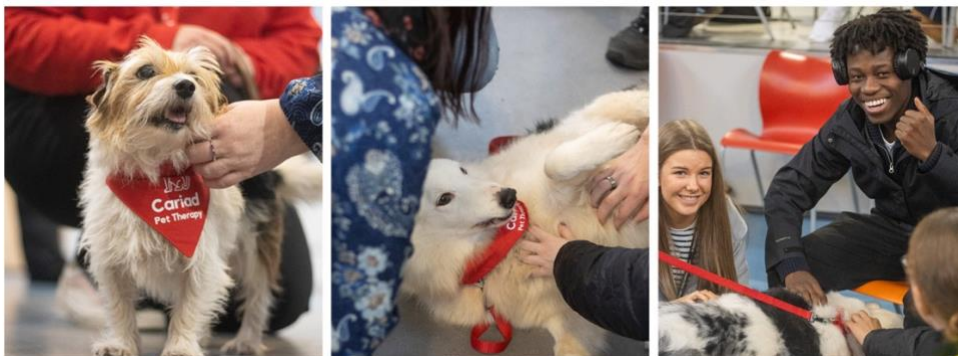


Staff highlighted the struggles of homelessness.

New Minibus Service to Cardiff Central

Student voice is valued at St David's in order to improve student experience.

Recently, we held a focus group about students' travel experiences to and from college. Many students commute to College by train and commented that the afternoon buses into the city centre were at capacity which sometimes meant they had to wait for quieter buses, which added considerably onto journey times. In response to this, the College is offering a free minibus shuttle service to Cardiff Central every afternoon. Places are limited so students have been asked to apply for a place. We will also review this service regularly.
